1 The Court, having considered the Stipulation to Extend the Temporary  
2 Restraining Order and Continue the Hearing on the Order to Show Cause Why a  
3 Preliminary Injunction Should Not be Granted and a Permanent Receiver Should Not  
4 be Appointed With Respect to Relief Defendants John Eric Francom, INR-  
5 Investment Holdings, LLC, and Alexandria Porter Bovee aka “Aia Montgomery” (the  
6 “Stipulating Relief Defendants”), incorporated herein, and good cause appearing,  
7 hereby **ORDERS** as follows:

8 1. The Parties’ stipulated request is **GRANTED**.


9 2. The TRO as to the Stipulating Relief Defendants is **EXTENDED** until

16 accounting of financials (as noted in paragraphs 9 and 10 of the TRO), such  
17 productions are due by the extended deadline of June 7, 2023, for the Stipulating  
18 Relief Defendants.
