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1 Krista Freitag ("Receiver"), the Court-appointed permanent receiver for Defendant, Integrated National Resources, Inc., dba Weedgenics, and Relief 2 Defendants, West Coast Development LLC, INR Consulting LLC (Wyoming Entity), Oceans 19 Inc., Autobahn Performance LLC, One Click General Media 4 Inc., Opus Collective, INR-CA Investment Holdings, LLC, Total Solution 5 Construction LLC, Bagpipe Holdings LLC, Bagpipe Multimedia LLC, INR 6 Consulting LLC (California Entity), and Hidden Springs Holdings Group LLC, and 7 their subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively the "Receivership Entities"), hereby 8 submits this Third Interim Application for Payment of Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses (the "Application"). This Application covers the period from October 1, 10 2023 through December 31, 2023 (the "Application Period"), and seeks approval of 11 \$138,837.75 in fees and \$18,733.10 in expenses, and an order authorizing the 12 Receiver to pay, on an interim basis, 80% of the fees incurred (\$111,070.20) and 13 100% of the expenses incurred (\$18,733.10). 14 **INTRODUCTION.** 15 I. This equity receivership involves a large, complex, and wide-ranging group 16 17 of enterprises and assets associated with the alleged \$61 million fraudulent scheme that is the subject of the Complaint filed by the Securities and Exchange 18 Commission (the "Commission"). The Receiver was appointed as temporary 19 20 receiver pursuant to a Temporary Restraining Order (the "TRO") dated May 19, 21 2023 (Dkt. 17) and as permanent receiver on June 2, 2023, pursuant to the 22 Preliminary Injunction Order with Respect to Certain Defendants and Relief 23 Defendants and Orders (1) Freezing Assets; (2) Appointing a Permanent Receiver; (3) Requiring Accountings; and (4) Prohibiting the Destruction of Documents (Dkt. 24 25 33) and subsequent Preliminary Injunction Orders entered between June 8, 2023 and

June 29, 2023 (Dkt. 48, 49, 93 95) (collectively, the "Appointment Order").

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The Appointment Order confers broad duties, responsibilities, and powers upon the Receiver, which are designed to allow her to secure, preserve, and protect the assets of the Receivership Entities, conduct a forensic accounting and analysis of the Receivership Entities' financial transactions, investigate and recover sums transferred to third parties, review and analyze investor and creditor claims, and maximize the amount ultimately available for distribution to investors and creditors. The Appointment Order also authorizes the Receiver to "employ attorneys, accountants, appraisers and others" to assist her in the performance of her duties. (e.g., Dkt. 33, Section 12(F)). The Receiver promptly determined that utilizing a few third-party vendors and her experienced staff at E3 Realty Advisors, Inc. dba E3 Advisors ("E3"), as well as experienced, qualified counsel was critical due to the lack of records, size and complexity of the receivership estate. Accordingly, the Receiver has used her team at E3 and engaged a few third-party vendors (e.g., forensic accounting and computer), to assist in carrying out receivership duties and engaged Allen Matkins Leck Gamble Mallory & Natsis LLP ("Allen Matkins") as her general counsel for the receivership. The Court approved the Receiver's engagement of Allen Matkins on July 28, 2023. Dkt. 125.

This Application should be read in conjunction with the Receiver's Fourth Interim Report and Recommendations ("Fourth Report") filed on February 13, 2024 (Dkt. 209), which describes in detail the Receiver's activities during the Application Period.

This Application seeks approval of \$138,837.75 in fees for a total of 487.8 hours worked, and payment on an interim basis of 80% of that amount, or \$111,070.20. The Receiver has agreed to discount her standard hourly rates by 10% for this case. The work performed is described task-by-task in **Exhibit A** and is broken down into the following categories:

The early phases of a complex equity receivership involve substantial work by the receiver and her professionals to (a) identify and secure assets, (b) preserve their value, (c) investigate and pursue recovery of funds disbursed from the Receivership Entities' accounts, (d) investigate any operations and/or issues associated therewith, if any, (e) gather and review key documents, (f) complete the Court-ordered forensic accounting and (g) advise the Court on the status of the Receiver's activities, among other areas of work.

Despite the challenges of getting little to no cooperation from defendants and relief defendants, the Receiver and her team have been able to make substantial progress in identifying, recovering and otherwise pursuing the Receivership Entities' assets and discharging her duties. Among other accomplishments, the Receiver and her team have managed to make progress on the ever-important forensic accounting and recover the following assets through December 31, 2023:

-- • Over \$8 million in cash,

- Fourteen (14) mostly exotic and luxury vehicles (two of which were recovered during the Application period upon the Court's rejection of Defendant Hirschmann's Ex Parte Motion for Modification of Order Approving Stipulation For Limited Modification to Preliminary Injunction with Respect to Certain Defendants and Relief Defendants, (Dkt 155) seeking to delay turnover of the real properties to the Receiver<sup>1</sup>),
- Six (6) real properties (two of which were recovered during the Application period upon the Court's rejection of the aforementioned Ex Parte motion), and
- Numerous pieces of jewelry and artwork.

The largest category of work - the Forensic Accounting category – represents over 48% of the fees incurred during the Application Period. An accounting is a critical tool in all cases, but particularly in this case as it has helped identify the assets recovered to date and other potentially recoverable assets. The accounting will also establish, among other things, where the funds obtained by the Receivership Entities came from and where they went after they were received by the Receivership Entities, as well as provide the foundation for the Receiver's review and analysis of investor/lender and other creditor claims. Of note, the breadth of this accounting in its entirety is anticipated to exceed 50,000 transactions.

As this type of receivership progresses, fees and costs generally decline as the assets are secured and protected, and procedures for the efficient administration of the receivership are put in place. There is substantial work still to be done, however,

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On September 25, 2023, the Court issued an Order Denying this Ex Parte Application (Dkt 160), requiring prompt turnover of the real properties.

including continued pursuit of asset recovery,<sup>2</sup> asset sales,<sup>3</sup> completion of the forensic accounting, investigation of causes of action and recovery therefrom, and the investor claims and distribution process.

The Receiver has worked diligently to describe in detail the work performed by her and her staff in the spreadsheet attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, and has worked diligently and efficiently on the urgent issues facing the receivership estate and in carrying out her Court-ordered duties and should be compensated on an interim basis for her work.

#### **SUMMARY OF TASKS PERFORMED AND COSTS INCURRED.** II.

#### Categories and Descriptions of Work. Α.

#### 1. **General Receivership.**

Services in this category relate to matters concerning the general administration of the receivership estate and the underlying litigation. The majority of the Receiver and her team's work in this category during the Application Period relate to ongoing efforts associated with the company's electronic data and with processing documentation and follow-on research associated with voluminous subpoenaed<sup>4</sup> records necessitated by the lack of cooperation and company records. These efforts have been critical in identifying and securing Receivership estate assets and potential recoverable assets/claims.

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The Receiver and her team have identified material transfers of receivership estate cash and other assets, recovery efforts for which remain ongoing.

Most fees incurred in this category are non-recurring. The reasonable and necessary fees for Receiver's work in this category total \$9,770.25.

#### 2. <u>Asset Investigation & Recovery.</u>

The substantial services in this category relate generally to efforts to investigate, identify, secure/preserve, and recover receivership estate assets. The vast majority of the work included in this category during the Application Period revolved around the Receiver and her team's securing possession of two luxury vehicles and two real property assets upon receipt of the Court's previously mentioned denial of Defendant Hirschmann's Ex Parte application. The Receiver also spent time on her motion for authority to pursue clawback claims (Dkt. 197).

Most fees incurred in this category are non-recurring. The reasonable and necessary fees for the Receiver's work in this category total \$7,428.00.

#### 3. <u>Asset Disposition.</u>

The Receiver's services in this category were focused on research, including potential broker and auctioneer interviews, associated with maximizing value of the recovered personal and real property assets in anticipation of the disposition thereof, as well as the preparation of the Receiver's Notice of Motion and Receiver's Motion for Authority to (A) Engage Licensed Auctioneers and Dealers to Assist in Selling Personal Property, (B) Sell Automobiles, Jewelry, and Other Personal Property of the Receivership Entities, and (C) Engage Brokers to List Real Properties for Sale filed on September 29, 2023 (Dkt. 162). The reasonable and necessary fees for Receiver's work in this category total \$10,991.25.

#### 4. Reporting.

The Receiver's services in this category were focused on preparing the Receiver's Third Interim Report and Recommendations, which was filed on December 15, 2023 (Dkt. 201). The reasonable and necessary fees for Receiver's work in this category total \$7,345.50.

#### 5. Accounting, Estate Administration

The majority of the work in this category during the Application Period was associated with handling various HOA communications regarding alleged pre-receivership violations at the Las Vegas residence, various tasks associated with transitioning possession of two residences in Boise, preparing analysis of improvements made thereto and general receivership estate related tasks. The tasks associated with transitioning possession of the two residences in Boise included items such as transition of utility accounts and identification of and engagement of professional management to properly winterize and regularly maintain the residences throughout the winter season.

The general, ongoing administration of the estate tasks include but are not limited to processing receivership estate mail and payables and generally accounting for the receivership estate. Such tasks are recurring during the pendency of the receivership; however, will decrease once the physical assets are monetized through the sale thereof. The reasonable and necessary fees for Receiver's work in this category total \$19,503.00.

#### 6. <u>Investors, Claims & Distributions.</u>

Services rendered in this category generally relate to the ever-important communication with investors and eventually the claims and distribution processes established for the benefit of the investors and creditors of the Receivership Entities.

During the Application Period, the Receiver and her team's time primarily represented responses to direct inquiries from investors regarding the receivership appointment, the impact of the receivership, and the prospective investor claims process as well as research associated with the investor contact list. The reasonable and necessary fees for Receiver's work in this category total \$7,373.25.

#### 7. **Operations**

As discussed in the Receiver's Second and Third Report, after reviewing the banking records and then documents and information produced by the web hosting

company in response to her subpoena, the Receiver discovered an operating business owned by Raw Sports, LLC (a Hirschmann controlled entity), which had recently purchased Rari Nutrition ("Rari"). Rari was a nutritional supplements company largely sold through the Amazon.com website, but also through its own website at rarinutrition.com.<sup>5</sup> Through various subpoenas, the Receiver confirmed that Raw Sports, LLC dba Rari was an existing operating business that Hirschmann purchased through Raw Sports, LLC, just prior to the Receiver's appointment with what appears to be investor funds. After the Receiver obtained this information, Hirschmann agreed to turn control of the company and its operations over to the Receiver, which took place in the last few days of June 2023.

During the Application Period, the Receiver continued to work with the experienced Amazon.com operations team, who was operating the virtual storefront. As previously reported, the Receiver had been working with this team in order to gain an understanding of the status of the operations and profitability thereof, the product and inventory status and feasibility of an eventual sale of the business. Unfortunately, the prior net losses reported, the limited revenue activity and complete lack of cooperation by the manufacturer of the supplements ultimately led to a wind down of operations during the Application Period.

The reasonable and necessary fees for the Receiver's work in this category total \$3,670.50 during the Application Period.

#### 8. Forensic Accounting

During the Application Period, this category reflects the Receiver's continued efforts in processing and uploading bank records as subpoenaed productions are received from the financial institutions, investor transaction focused categorization,

potential clawback transaction analysis and otherwise, the early stages of the global forensic categorization process.

And while the Receiver commenced her forensic accounting in earnest, critical bank records and other credit card records were and are still being obtained (and more have been identified as the accounting has progressed). Due to the complexity and scope of the scheme, the number of affiliated entities and bank accounts used, the high volume of transfers to, from, and between Receivership Entities and the defendants and relief defendants, and the lack of any company accounting or investor data, the forensic accounting project will take time to complete. That said, because of the critical nature of bank record review, the Receiver is using a project-specific and cost-effective AI software to upload the tens of thousands of banking transactions into a database. This software will save considerable time and expense and shorten the period of time required to complete the accounting, which in some complex cases can take years (depending on the number of bank accounts and volume of transactions). At this time, the global forensic work is anticipated to exceed 50,000 transactions.

This accounting is a critical tool in all cases, but particularly in this case as it has provided for the identification and recovery of material assets and prospectively recoverable assets, and it will establish, among other things, where the funds obtained by the Receivership Entities came from and where they went after they were received by the Receivership Entities. The accounting will also provide the foundation for the Receiver's review and analysis of investor/lender and other creditor claims. The reasonable and necessary fees for Receiver's work in this category total \$66,714.75.

#### 9. Taxes

During the Application Period, this category reflects the Receiver's early-stage work on the receivership entity tax reporting research and review. The reasonable and necessary fees for Receiver's work in this category total \$6,041.25.

#### B. Summary of Expenses Requested for Reimbursement.

The Receiver requests that the Court approve reimbursement of \$18,733.10 in out-of-pocket costs. The itemization of such expenses is attached hereto as Exhibit B and is summarized below by category. The majority of the expenses incurred relate to special conflicts counsel assistance with the Receiver's subpoenas to Google and processing of responsive records as well as to the Receiver's third-party forensic computer expert. Other expenses incurred include travel costs for the two Boise residence inspections/transition, the forensic AI software and other miscellaneous receivership administrative and asset related costs.

The total for costs incurred by the Receiver during the Application Period is \$18,733.10 and is broken down by category as follows:

#### III. STANDARDIZED FUND ACCOUNTING REPORT

Attached hereto as **Exhibit** C is a Standardized Fund Accounting Report, which includes information on receipts and disbursements since the inception of the receivership.

# IV. THE FEES AND COSTS ARE REASONABLE AND SHOULD BE ALLOWED.

"As a general rule, the expenses and fees of a receivership are a charge upon the property administered." *Gaskill v. Gordon*, 27 F.3d 248, 251 (7th Cir. 1994). These expenses include the fees and expenses of this Receiver and her professionals, including Allen Matkins. Decisions regarding the timing and amount of an award of fees and costs to the Receiver and her professionals are committed to the sound discretion of the Court. *See SEC v. Elliot*, 953 F.2d 1560, 1577 (11th Cir. 1992) (rev'd in part on other grounds, 998 F.2d 922 (11th Cir. 1993)).

In allowing fees, a court should consider "the time, labor and skill required, but not necessarily that actually expended, in the proper performance of the duties imposed by the court upon the receiver . . . , the fair value of such time, labor and skill measured by conservative business standards, the degree of activity, integrity and dispatch with which the work is conducted and the result obtained." *United States v. Code Prods. Corp.*, 362 F. 2d 669, 673 (3d Cir. 1966) (internal quotation marks omitted). In practical terms, receiver and professional compensation thus ultimately rests upon the result of an equitable, multi-factor balancing test involving the "economy of administration, the burden that the estate may be able to bear, the amount of time required, although not necessarily expended, and the overall value of the services to the estate." *In re Imperial 400 Nat'l, Inc.*, 432 F.2d 232, 237 (3d Cir. 1970). Regardless of how this balancing test is formulated, no single factor is determinative and "a reasonable fee is based [upon] all circumstances surrounding the receivership." *SEC v. W.L. Moody & Co., Bankers (Unincorporated)*, 374 F. Supp. 465, 480 (S.D. Tex. 1974).

As a preliminary matter, the Appointment Order confer on the Receiver substantial duties and powers, including to conduct such investigation and discovery as may be necessary to locate and account for all receivership assets, to take such action as is necessary and appropriate to assume control over and preserve

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receivership assets, and to employ attorneys and others to investigate and, where appropriate, institute, pursue, and prosecute all claims and causes of action of whatever kind and nature. *See* Appointment Order, Section X.

As previously noted, the Receiver promptly determined that utilizing a few third-party vendors and her experienced staff at E3 as well as experienced, qualified counsel was critical due to the lack of records, size and complexity of the receivership estate. The Receiver sought approval and the Court approved her engagement of Allen Matkins and the ability to file interim reports and fee applications on a quarterly basis via the Order Regarding Aid of Receivership. Dkt. 60.

The Receiver has submitted a detailed fee application which describes the nature of the services rendered, and the identity and billing rate of each individual performing each task. *See* **Exhibit A**. The Receiver endeavors to staff matters as efficiently as possible, while remaining cognizant of the complexity of issues presented. The request for fees is based on the Receiver's customary billing rates charged for comparable services provided in other matters, less a 10% discount.

The work performed by the Receiver and her team was essential to carrying out the Receiver's Court-ordered duties. The Receiver and Allen Matkins have worked diligently since the Receiver's appointment to preserve and protect the assets of the receivership estate, maximize the funds available for ultimate distribution to investors, and carry out the Receiver's other duties pursuant to the Appointment Order. Moreover, the Receiver seeks payment of only 80% of fees incurred on an interim basis in recognition of the fact that her work is ongoing. Payment of the proposed 20% holdback will be sought at the conclusion of the receivership. The Receiver's fees are fair and reasonable and should be approved and paid on an interim basis.

V. **CONCLUSION.** 1 The Receiver therefore respectfully request that this Court enter an Order: 2 Approving the Receiver's fees of \$138,837.75; 3 1. Authorizing and directing the Receiver to pay 80% of approved fees, or 2. 4 \$111,070.20, from the assets of the Receivership Entities; 5 Approving the Receiver's costs in the amount of \$18,733.10, and 6 3. authorizing and directing the Receiver to reimburse such costs in full; and 7 4.
